CITY OF LADONIA, FANNIN COUNTY TEXAS ORDINANCE NO. 2011-07-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LADONIA, TEXAS, ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED BY METES AND BOUNDS; DECLARING THE VARIOUS PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE TO BE SEVERABLE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Ladonia, Texas, owns real property that is contiguous adjacent to the city limits but is not inside the city limits; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ladonia, Texas, desires to bring such real property into the city limits; and

WHEREAS, the real property is less than one-half mile in width; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest and welfare to extend the boundaries of the City of Ladonia, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LADONIA, TEXAS:

Section 1. The land and territory described in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof the same as if set forth at length, lying adjacent to and adjoining the present boundaries of the City of Ladonia, Texas, is hereby added and annexed to the City of Ladonia, Texas, and the land described in Exhibit "A" shall hereinafter be included within the boundary limits of the City of Ladonia, Texas, and the present boundary limits of the City are altered and amended so as to include the area within the corporate limits of the City of Ladonia, Texas.

Section 2. Municipal services shall be extended to the land described on Exhibit "A" when there is a need for such services.

Section 3. There are not any inhabitants on the property described in Exhibit "A" and there are not any living quarters on the property. If, in the future, living quarters are erected on the property described on Exhibit "A" then the residents will be entitled to the same rights and privileges as any other citizen of the City of Ladonia, Texas, and shall be

subject to all of the regulations and laws of the City of Ladonia, Texas.

Section 4. In the event that any Court of competent jurisdiction shall rule any part or parts of this ordinance void, the rest and remainder of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effective.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage by the City Council of the City of Ladonia, Texas.

Section 6. The City Secretary is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the County Clerk of Fannin County, Texas.

THENCE: S 00°48'44" E with the East line of County Road 3660 a distance of 1530.00 feet to a point for the Southeast corner of this tract.

THENCE: N 89°27'12" W passing the West line of the 86.065 acre F.
