Construction is complete for the City of Ladonia, Texas Water Development Board Project No. 62616 DWSRF Water Distribution System Improvements project. The project was wholly funded by the DWSRF and consisted of the following:

- 1. Waterline Replacements: Construction of approximately 3,427 LF of 1 O" water line, 12,712 LF of 8" waterline, 6,510 linear feet of 6" waterline, encasement, valves, services, fittings, fire hydrants and necessary appurtenances for improvements to the City of Ladonia's water distribution system.
- 2. Pump Station Improvements: Construction of site work, a new 11' x 11' well house, site piping, chlorination system, fencing and electrical improvements at well site #1, construction of a pump building, site piping, a chlorination system, and all associated pumps, valves, piping, electrical improvements and appurtenances at well site #2, and construction of a 200,000 gallon ground storage tank and all related appurtenances.
- 3. Elevated Tank Improvements: Cleaning, surface preparation and recoating of all exterior and interior surfaces of a 100,000 gallon double ellipsoidal elevated tank, removal and replacement of tank accessories, and extension of the overflow pipe and construction of a new splash pad.
